As Diane Dady moves into retirement, we're excited to introduce you to our new Mobridge Regional Hospital and Clinics' pharmacist and Director of Pharmacy, Lee Cordell.

Cordell comes to us from White Drug Pharmacy, in Deadwood. "The fact that Mobridge is on the river was the first thing to pique my interest," he said. "My family loves to be on the water, and the fishing is hard to beat. But after visiting a few times, it was honestly the people that brought us to Mobridge. Everyone my wife, daughter, and I interacted with was so friendly and helpful."

In addition to his pharmacy work, Cordell has also been a part-time inspector for the South Dakota State Board of Pharmacy, traveling across the western part of the state to ensure quality practices. "Inspecting pharmacies gives me an opportunity to stay on top of things such as sterile and hazardous compounding," he

said. "And as the world of pharmacy is ever-changing, it helps me keep a heads up on anything coming down the pipeline in order to serve patients better."

Cordell realizes he has big shoes to fill. "Diane Dady's name is synonymous with the profession of pharmacy in South Dakota," he said. "She's done an amazing job. I'm looking forward to working with her during our transition and building upon everything she's created." Cordell is especially excited that the pharmacy facilities under construction in MRH&C's new wing will enable chemotherapy to be prepared and delivered on-site.

"This hits close to home for me as my brother is currently going through chemotherapy and has to travel several hours multiple times a week during treatment weeks," he said. "Being able to offer this locally in a community this size is amazing and speaks volumes about the organization that is willing to do everything it can to provide enhanced care to local residents."

All MRH&C facilities use the same electronic medical record system. Scheduling is also centralized. This makes care easy and convenient, no matter which facility, provider, or service a patient might need.

MRH also serves as a hub for all of the health system's laboratory work, imaging, and pharmacy services.
