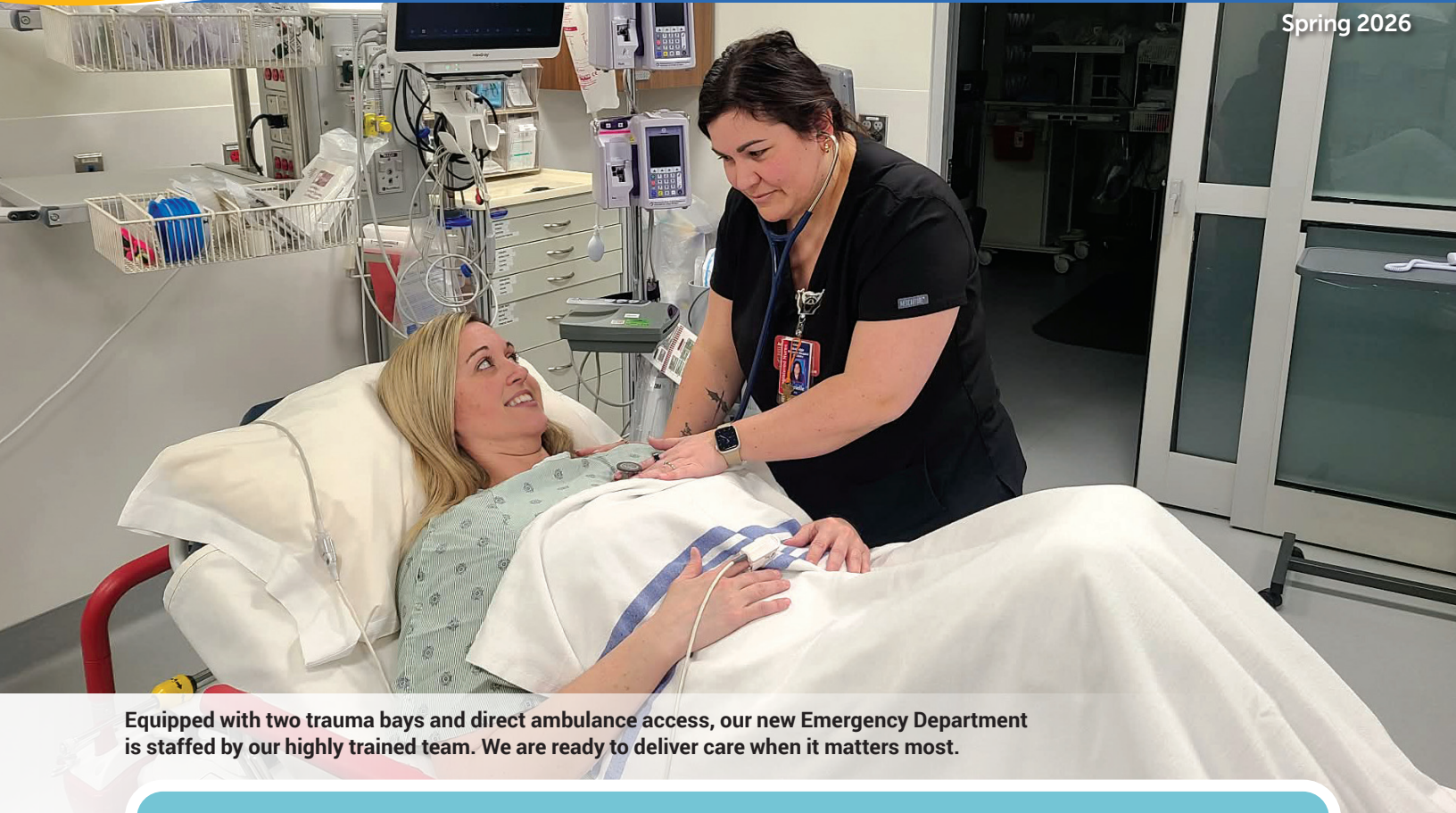




Equipped with two trauma bays and direct ambulance access, our new Emergency Department is staffed by our highly trained team. We are ready to deliver care when it matters most.

“It’s a busy department, and it’s nice to have a new, more efficient space,” said Dixie Artz, RN, Nurse Manager and Inservice Coordinator.

If you or your loved ones find yourselves in need of emergency medical care, you’ll be glad to know that the Emergency Department at Mobridge Regional Hospital has been expanded, revamped, and relocated within the building to better serve you.

The ER—which was previously located on the south end of the hospital and is now on the north—was renovated as part of the comprehensive building project that has taken on numerous facility improvements over the past four years, including a new patient wing, pharmacy, and infusion center on the northwest corner of the campus as well as many interior upgrades.

Dr. Emily Boden Now Seeing Patients in Timber Lake

Family doctor
and Timber Lake
native **Emily
Boden, MD**,
has practiced
at Mobridge
Medical Clinic
since 2018—and
now patients



can also receive care from her at West
Dakota Health Center in Timber Lake.

In addition to primary care for people
of all ages, Dr. Boden provides prenatal
and OB care to pregnant women.

“I am a Family Medicine/OB physician
with a special interest in OB, maternity
care, women’s health, and pediatrics,”
she said. “We are able to provide
basic prenatal visits in Timber Lake
with plans for the patient to deliver
at Mobridge Hospital. This means
women can receive prenatal care from
the provider who will be the delivering
physician when the time comes for
mom to have baby. With coordination,
we can also do prenatal ultrasounds
and antenatal testing in Mobridge.”

Dr. Boden also provides postpartum
and women’s care, including cervical
cancer screening, pelvic health,
contraception management, and
preventive medicine. “As a family
medicine doctor, I also provide
pediatric care from newborn until
adulthood,” she said. “This has a
special advantage for continuity
of care, as I can care for both the
pregnant mother and her newborn
after delivery.”

New and Improved Emergency Room Is Ready to Serve You *continued from the cover*

The new ER opened in December. In a typical year, our Emergency Department handles about 5,000 emergency visits, including caring for nearly 100 trauma patients—people who have suffered life-threatening injuries from incidents such as car accidents and serious falls.

What to Expect

The updated ER includes eight patient rooms—including one isolation room if needed to prevent the spread of infectious diseases, and one that serves as an OB room for obstetrics patients in need of urgent care—as well as two fully equipped, spacious trauma bays. It's adjacent to the imaging department, so when urgent X-rays, CTs, or other images are needed to diagnose and treat ER patients, the process is more efficient.

In general, the ER is now more comfortable, up-to-date, and private. Where there were once curtains between trauma beds, for example, there are now separate rooms with doors. The ER has also gained its own waiting area.



Located just inside the main ER entrance, this newly renovated waiting area is comfortable for patients and families. A smaller waiting room is just around the corner.



Our new ER entrance is easy to access. If you arrive after hours, simply ring the buzzer on the wall and our staff will assist you.

"It's more modern," Artz said. "People are often surprised by how large and open it feels. The additional space allows our team to work more efficiently, and it improves the experience for our patients."

The new ER also includes an EMS office, so all staff and providers responsible for emergency and critical care can work together in close proximity. A new ambulance garage is attached to the west side of the ER for direct access.

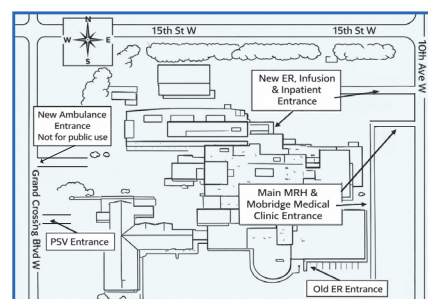
New to the team is Danielle Akron, a staff nurse at MRH&C for the past six years, who has assumed the role of ER Critical Care and Trauma Coordinator. She brings a wealth of knowledge to the department, and the team is excited to have her in this leadership position.

Where to Go

If you are experiencing a life-threatening emergency, the fastest way to receive care is to call 911, as EMS crews will begin delivering care as soon as they arrive at your location.

If your care need is not an immediate emergency and you drive to Mobridge Regional Hospital, follow the signs on campus. Use the north entrance off 10th Avenue W, and park in the north parking lot.

As always, the ER is open 24/7, 365 days a year. If you arrive between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday-Friday, you will simply enter through the emergency entrance. Outside of those hours, press the buzzer within the ER vestibule to be admitted.
