Over the past four years, much of the attention at Mobridge Regional Hospital & Clinics has understandably been focused on our four phase construction and

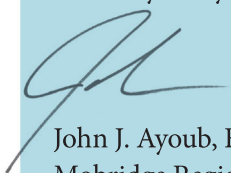
renovation project. The transformation of our campus has been significant, creating more efficient workflows, expanding services, and giving our team an environment to match their performance.

For Jackie Hanna, returning to Mobridge feels like coming home. She grew up in Timber Lake and began her nursing career at MRH&C in 2010 before spending the past 14 years in the Black Hills. Now, as a psychiatric nurse practitioner, she's returning to the community where her passion for rural behavioral healthcare first took shape.

"This is where my heart is," Hanna said.

She looks forward to providing in-person behavioral health care, medication management, and community outreach focused on prevention, suicide awareness, and helping people recognize when someone may need support. With no local psychiatric provider within 80 miles, either direction, her arrival fills a significant need for the region.

For Dr. Andrew Hoffman, Mobridge offers something increasingly uncommon in today's healthcare environment—a collaborative team committed to doing what's best for patients. After years of practicing trauma and acute care surgery across the country, he values the opportunity to provide consistent surgical coverage and help more patients receive evaluations and procedures without unnecessary travel.

"I came in during the last portion of the recent construction project, so I didn't see much of it. There's so much merging of smaller institutions into larger ones throughout the country."

"When you see a facility like this, and an administration that's willing to do what's necessary for their community, then they're doing something right," Hoffman reflected.

"We have a surgeon available year-round now," Hoffman said. "Being able to evaluate patients here before deciding whether additional specialty care is needed is very important."

As a certified nurse practitioner, Mason Keller appreciates working alongside a team that shares a common purpose. He says the organization's continued growth reflects its commitment to bringing more services to the region while ensuring residents have access to high-quality healthcare where they live and work.

"Rural healthcare is about making sure people have access to quality care regardless of where they live," Keller said. "Building relationships and trust with our patients is one of the most rewarding parts of what we do."

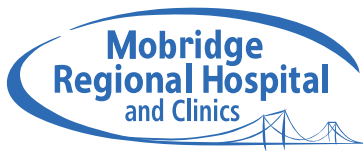
