Count yourself lucky to have a well-equipped, high-quality emergency department near your home. As rural hospitals close around the nation, millions of Americans are left in what's called a "hospital desert"—living more than 30 miles from a hospital with emergency

care, according to a 2017 study by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Since MRH&C is the only hospital with a trauma center within a couple hours' drive, emergency department (ED) staff are used to handling thousands of emergencies each year.

Only Major Trauma Center Within 100 Miles

"We are the only major trauma center within 100 miles in three directions, and 250 miles in the fourth direction," said Dr. Robert Marciano, medical director of MRH&C's emergency department.

Most trauma and emergency cases can be cared for right here at home. On rare occasions (less than 4% of the time) a patient needs advanced specialty care and needs to be transferred out. When this happens, the hospital calls on a fixed wing plane, helicopter, or ambulance to quickly transport patients to Bismarck, Fargo, Aberdeen, or Minneapolis.

Trauma Certified Physicians & Nurses

Mobridge attracts top doctors who want to practice in a beautiful, rural setting. All five physicians in the emergency department are board certified, and all have been certified by

the American College of Surgeons in Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS).

"In addition, all of our nurses in the emergency department are trauma certified. We are also proficient in specialty areas including obstetrics and pediatrics," said Chloe Stulken, MSN, RN-BC, ED Supervisor and Trauma Coordinator for MRH&C.

Hospital-based EMS Team

Most small, rural hospitals do not see near the volume that MRH&C sees of trauma cases each year, making them extra efficient and responsive. To ensure quality, the ED and ambulance teams continually train and receive education on leading-edge treatment protocols.

"Since we are hospital based, we have good communication with the emergency department providers who trust us and our knowledge to provide great medical care," concluded Chuck Hanson, EMS Director.

medical school at University of Illinois and completed his residency at Boston University. From there, he started a private practice in Boston and was president of the medical staff at Milton hospital where he oversaw 123 surgeons. He gained quite a reputation and was sought out by the rich and famous—including a Secretary of State and one of the 10 wealthiest men in America.

After years of practicing in Boston, he realized something was missing—his dream of being a small town doctor—and that's when he came to Mobridge the first time. He fell in love with the area and the people.

"After retiring last October, I realized I wasn't ready to stop. I was missing all the satisfaction of doing surgery," he added.

Dr. Lucek is a very driven man, who is constantly exploring the latest breakthroughs. He completed a fellowship in patient safety, visited Canada's world renowned Shouldice Hernia Hospital to learn their successful approach, and completed a colorectal clinic at the Mayo Clinic.

"I get excellent results, but I still want to do better and learn from the best," Dr. Lucek said.

Dr. Lucek believes MRH&C has a better set up for operations than most bigger city hospitals. The hospital recently purchased brand new equipment to perform laparoscopic surgeries including a high definition (think 4k vs 1020HD) camera and scope. MRH&C is happy to have Dr. Lucek return to Mobridge.

Concussions and Fall Sports

With the start of fall sports, it's important to be aware of the signs of concussion. Symptoms of a concussion include headache, confusion, trouble focusing, balance problems,

heightened emotions, nausea, vomiting, and light or noise sensitivity immediately after impact and even 24 hours or more later.

"If your child receives a hard impact, it's best to pull them from the game and have them evaluated to prevent further injury," said Heather Olson, PA-C, CIC, certified concussion specialist with MRH&C.

Olson performs baseline testing before the sports season begins on student athletes at area schools, including Mobridge, Timber Lake, and McLaughlin.
